

**THE JUANITA AND RALPH HARVEY SCHOOL OF VISUAL ARTS
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Currently Enrolled or Transfer Student Applicants

The Juanita and Ralph Harvey School of Visual Arts awards scholarships each year to outstanding **full time Art majors**. These scholarship amounts vary but do not exceed \$4000 for the academic year. They are awarded and retained based on the recipient's **performance, overall attitude, leadership qualities, G.P.A. and potential as a professional artist, and a review of their portfolio**. Recipients must be enrolled in at least twelve (12) hours each semester, unless student is a graduating senior or student teaching. Applicants should have a minimum overall GPA of **2.80**, and an Art GPA of **3.00**. The amount of the scholarship is deducted from tuition and fees at the time of registration. Applicants should also be aware that the amount of money available for scholarships each year may vary according to the total funds earned by the scholarship endowment. All scholarships are awarded for one school year only; therefore, you must reapply for consideration for the next year. Please comply with the following guidelines for the submission of your portfolio:

1. The portfolio will consist of no less than five and no more than ten actual works in their completed state. Work is acceptable matted or mounted, and/or framed as appropriate.
2. It is in the best interest of the applicant to include both two and three-dimensional work when possible. All works must be completed since leaving high school, and must be from the past two years, emphasis should be placed on most recent work.
3. Slides may be submitted, in addition to the maximum number of actual artworks. However, they will not be accepted in place of completed work unless a prospective student making application (prior to enrolling) is from a geographic distance, which precludes transporting a portfolio to Midwestern State University. Such (a) student(s) may submit their portfolio in slide form.
4. Requests for exemptions to these guidelines must be submitted in written form to the art scholarship committee.
