- 2. A copy of your high school transcripts from all high schools attended.
- 3. Your ACT and SAT scores, if available, however exit TAKS scores must be included.
- 4. A portfolio of work and/or slides of photographs of your best work must accompany this application. Actual work is best.

All scholarships are awarded for one academic year only; therefore, scholarship recipients must reapply every year.

Please comply with the following guidelines for the submission of your portfolio:

- 1. The portfolio will consist of no less than five or more than ten actual completed works of art. Work must be matted or mounted, and/or framed as appropriate.
- 2. It is in the best interest of the applicant to include both two and three-dimensional work if possible. All works must have been completed in the past two years. Emphasis should be placed on most recent work.
- 3. Slides may be submitted, in addition to the maximum number of actual art works. However, they will not be accepted in place of completed work **unless** a prospective student making application (prior to enrolling) is from a geographic distance, which precludes transporting a portfolio to Midwestern State University. Such (a) student(s) may submit their portfolio in slide form.
