Consideration of applications will begin upon receipt of all documents. Priority deadline to apply is January 15.

Requirements for admission:

1. Applicants must be unconditionally accepted for admission to Midwestern State University. 2. Applicants must have the following entrance exam scores (excluding writing) and high school class rank: ACT = 25 + and/or SAT = 1130 + and Top 25%

3. Applicants must have official SAT and/or ACT scores on file sent from College Board or ACT.

*****PLEASE NOTE:** Applicants who have been awarded the President's Distinguished Scholarship (PDS) are not eligible to receive the Redwine Honors Program Scholarship. PDS scholars are welcome to participate in Redwine Honors Program activities, live in Honors housing (if space is available), and enroll in Honors courses. If PDS scholars are interested in being a part of the Redwine Honors Program, they should stop by the office in Moffett Library, Room 112D, and visit with the program coordinator.
