Application for the Jerry and Nan Warren Scholarship for Fall 2023

The Jerry and Nan Warren Scholarship will be \$500 awarded for the fall 2023 academic year.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the faculty of the Midwestern State University Sociology Program. To be eligible to receive this Scholarships, the student must meet these minimum qualifications during each semester in which the scholarship is received:

- The student must be a sociology major at Midwestern State University.
- The student must be a junior or senior (i.e., 60 or more credit hours completed by the end of the current semester).
- The student must show a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- The student must show a 3.0 grade point average in sociology courses.
- The student must maintain enrollment in at least 12 credit hours at Midwestern, including at least one course in sociology, during each semester in which the scholarship is received.

Applications for the Jerry and Nan Warren Scholarship are for either a fall or spring semester. Current scholarship recipients must reapply to be considered in subsequent years. The Jerry and Nan Scholarship is awarded for an entire academic year, but is paid in the fall or spring semester.
