- Students will be allowed to browse the closet and select items. Our staff will assist each student with the best possible outfit choice.

Prior to checking out the selected items, a borrower must complete the following requirements:

1. Provide either a valid MSU Student ID Card or an MSU Alumni Association Membership Card
2. Create a MustangsHIRE account or update an existing MustangsHIRE account within the current semester
3. Submit a resume and cover letter for critique in the current semester
4. Participate in a mock interview in the current semester
5. Pay dry cleaning fee of \$_____
6. Sign Career Closet Usage Agreement
7. **Return all items by _____**
