



Access the Audio-Video Editor in the Classic Content Experience:


1. From your course homepage, click on **Content**.



2. Navigate to the module of your choice. Click **New** and select **Video or Audio**.



3. In the **Add Video or Audio** window, select the **Upload** tab. **Browse** for your file, or drag your video file into the upload space.



4. The upload process begins **Note:** The transcoding process starts when the file reaches 70% upload and may result in a momentary pause.

5. When the upload is complete **enter a title** and select **Advanced Editing**.

Edit Timelines






Add Captions
