Proctor a test	Lockdown Browser and/or Monitor.
Require group work	Groups tool in D2L.
Provide feedback	<u>Gradebook or the Send Email</u> tool.
Make an announcement	The News Item tool in D2L.
Share a course event	Calendar tool in D2L.
Share a syllabus	Upload document to D2L using "Content" tool.
Share a website or many websites	Content - "Create a link" tool in D2L.
Have students present to one another	<u>Discussion</u> tool in D2L or <u>TEAMS</u> OR <u>Virtual Classroom</u> or <u>Zoom</u> .
Communicate with students	<u>Send Email</u> tool, <u>The News Item</u> tool, or meet in <u>TEAMS</u> or
	<u>Virtual Class</u> room or <u>Zoom</u> .
Host Office Hours	<u>TEAMS</u> or <u>Virtual Classroom</u> or <u>Zoom</u> .
Have in class discussions	<u>Discussion</u> tool in D2L or <u>TEAMS</u> or <u>Virtual Classroom</u> or <u>Zoom</u> .
Have a one-on-one session	TEAMS or Virtual Classroom or Zoom.
Show a video in class	Virtual Classroom/Video Assignments or post a Youtube video or Zoom.
Issue a journal assignment	Assignment tool in D2L.
