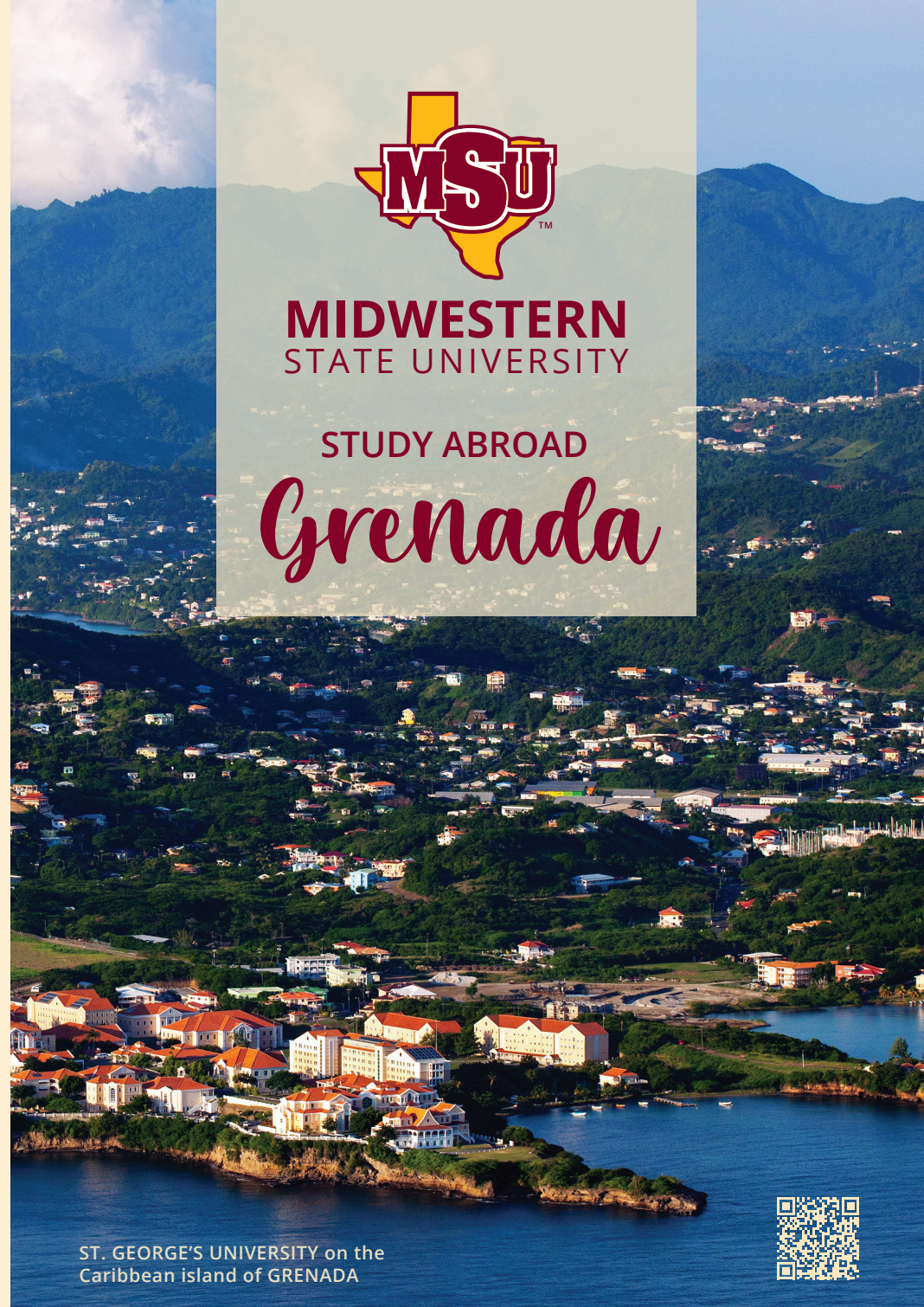

From colonialism to democracy, the island has an intriguing history and culture that blends traditions from European, South American, and African nations.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

St. George’s University, a medical, veterinary, and arts and sciences school, will be our base of operations, providing classroom space, learning laboratories, and housing for students and faculty. MSU Texas faculty will teach all of our classes and they will be complemented by guest lecturers from St. George’s University and site visits to health and wellness facilities around the island.

Classes will meet five days a week with some free time on the weekends. Program staff will plan social weekend activities for students as part of the program. You will travel in a group accompanied by MSU Texas faculty and staff. The program will last approximately 16 days including travel time, and will take place late May through early June.



PROGRAM COST INCLUDES

- Travel: Round trip airfare from DFW to Grenada and coach transfers
- MSU Texas tuition and fees
- Lodging at SGU
- Weekend catamaran cruise
- Limited SGU shuttle service around local area

Remaining meals and personal expenses will be the student’s responsibility.

FINANCIAL AID
