

# **Summary on Work Hour Limits for Non Benefit Eligible Employees**

## **Student Assistants**

- May work up to 20 hours per week (all positions combined)
- \*Exceptions to work up to 29 hrs per week may be permitted (VP approval required), BUT only for 60 days.

#### **International Students**

- May work no more than 20 hours per week during long semesters (Fall & Spring all positions combined)
- A max of 29 hrs per week may be permitted (VP approval required), BUT for only <u>60</u> days and only during:
  - Spring Break ( 5 weekdays, plus the Saturday and Sunday before and after)
  - Summer (day after May graduation through day before August classes start)
  - Winter Break (day after December graduation through day before January classes start)

## **Graduate Assistants**

- May work up to 19 hrs per week
- Insurance eligibility begins at 20+ hours

# **Temporary Employees**

- May work up to 19 hrs per week
- \*Exceptions to work up to 29 hrs per week may be permitted, BUT only for 60 days.

\*\*NOTE: Beyond the 60 day window, per ACA guidelines, employment of 30+ hours per week leads to possible insurance eligibility with a full state contribution. Upon audit, possible penalties up to \$2,000 per employee at MSU at the time of violation.
